#### President's Report – Lisa Johnson Cooper

- Council voted on member Simab Aziz's 4<sup>th</sup> unexcused absence. There was a vote on whether to accept the absences for August, Sept, Oct and Nov. All members in attendance voted not to accept member Aziz's unexcused absences.

  - \*Analyzed district-wide data from the sprint 2022 NYS Assessments, fall 2022 Acadiance Assessment and Fall 2022 Map Growth Assessment
  - \*Continue to communicate Districtwide data trends to the community in a formulate that is easy to understand.
  - \*Staff the Far Rockaway Empowerment Center with District 27 staff to support family center
  - \*Engage in 1 to 1 discussion with every principal to determine what support structure would work best to schools, and more.

- Grades 7 & 8 Reading Map Growth
- Grades 3 & 4 Math Map Growth
- Grade 5 & 6 Math Map Growth
- Grade 7 & 8 Math Map Growth
- Acadience (Reading K – 2) – The district has also funded 40 District 27 principals to begin training on the science of reading through the LETRS Program
- Acadience Learning – Reading K-2 grade
  - \*What does this measure? Individual student foundational reading skills and projected reading proficiency ability
  - 1)First Sound Fluency
  - 2)Phoneme Segmentation Fluency
  - 3)NonSense Word Fluency
  - 4)Oral Reading Fluency
  - 5)Retell

FirstSound Fluency - 2022-23 Beginning of the year

- In our district, 62% of our kindergartens are below being able to identify the 1<sup>st</sup> sound in a word, 12% of K-2 students are at grade level in first sound Fluency and 25% of K-2 students are above grade level in 1<sup>st</sup> sound fluency
- Phoneme Segmentation Fluency 2022-23 – In D27, 11% of K-2 students are above grade level in phoneme Segmentation Fluency
- In D27, 10% of K-2 students are at grade level in phoneme segmentation fluency and 80% of K-2 students are below grade level in phoneme segmentation Fluency.
